The NETCAC is a non-profit 501-(c) 3 organization that offers a safe child friendly environment to children between the ages of 2-17 who allegedly have been sexually or severely physically abused or have been a witness to a violent crime.

The children who come to the NETCAC are allowed to tell their experiences in a non-leading way to a trained forensic interviewer rather than having to repeat it multiple times to multiple agencies involved in the investigation and prosecution, therefore reducing the trauma to the child.

Currently, we are able to offer these services free of charge, thanks to grant assistance, financial assistance from area businesses and civic organizations, gifts-in-kind, community support, and the CAC board members and volunteers.

### Texas Statistics show that

- 1 in 4 Girls & 1 in 6 Boys is sexually abused before their 18th birthday
  - More than 98% of these children know who their abuser is
  - Abuse does not discriminate....no matter the age, gender, financial status, or religious background.... NO Child is IMMUNE!
  - Perpetrators can be Mom, Dad, Stepparent, Foster Parent, Aunt, Uncle, Grandparent, Pastor, Coach, Teacher, Babysitter, Sibling, Cousin, etc.
- They not only Groom the child and the family but the entire community!
