Hello Church Family,

I am so excited to begin my journey into Children's Ministry! After much thought, prayer and talks with Debbie, we have planned some fun activities for the children. I will need help with set up and monitoring the children with the different activities and I hope you'll want to be part of the excitement!

Sunday Morning Children's Church, K-5th Grades:

Children's Church will be happening in Wesley Hall during the same time as regular worship every Sunday except the first Sunday of the month. On communion Sundays, the children will join their parents in worship. I will need some adults that can help with set up, crafts and small groups. I plan to have worship time with songs and a story, we will have craft time, game time, snack time and some small group time where the children can discuss the story and Bible verse for the day. I plan to end with more worship song time.

Middle School, 6th-8th Grades:

We have several 5th graders that will be going into middle school that will be graduating out of children's ministries and Kids Beach Club and need a place to connect. On Wednesday June 22 from 6-8:30pm, we will have a pizza and movie night at the Family Life Center for the middle schoolers. I will need 2-4 adults that can come help with chaperoning the pizza and movie night to make sure we comply with being ministry safe. We want these youth to have a safe space to hang out and a place that feels like their own. Let's show them that this is their church to learn and grow in and they can develop their relationship with Christ and one another here!

Wacky Wild Wednesdays:

On Wednesday evenings in July from 6-7:15 pm, we will have Wacky Wild Wednesdays. On these evenings, there will be a very informal dinner of hot dogs and chips and then water games. I will need about 6-8 adults to help with set up, dinner and monitoring of the "wild" water games. We plan to have water balloons, water guns and water slides. Maybe one night will even be a watermelon seed spitting contest! Pastor Debbie will lead a short Bible study for the adults on the "wacky" things the Bible says so all things WACKY and WILD!
